The role of the researcher at CNR: From research to technology transfer

Basic research today feels strongly driven by market demand. For this reason a researcher must not only deal with science, with the study of materials and their characterization but above all with their application. The role of technology transfer, the enhancement of research products are fundamental principles for the growth of our country in accordance with the lines of action of the European community (**The National Recovery and Resilience Plan, PNRR**). The importance of planning, the types of funding, the strategies to be implemented and the opportunities for researchers will be discussed during the seminar. Furthermore, the activities promoted by a technology transfer office to support the valorization of research will be illustrated: scouting to identify research results in specific areas of industrial property, creation of networks, organization of meetings with companies for the enhancement of research results, support to company creation (SPINOFF, IP management).
